- 19/01688/TCA Ackworth School – To undertake all the work specified in the Tree Survey submitted with the application.
- 19/01750/TPO 2 The Elms – removal of dying Sycamore tree
- 19/01887/TCA Avondale 50A Pontefract Road – TG1 Cypress – remove group

- 19/01960/TPO Hundhill Lodge, 3 Hundhill Lane - T1 Acacia reduction of limb going over side road by 2m. Reduction of limb over drive by 3m. Reduction of limb over grass to front by 2m; T2 beech raise lower canopy to 4m all around by secondary growth removal to accommodate access road and keep in balance. T3 Beech closest to house, raise canopy all round to 4m. Reduction of branch work going out towards the property by 2m.
- 19/01961/TPO 2 The Stables, Hundhill Lane – T4 Sycamore; fell to ground level. Large cavity around 8ft high on stem. This column of decay extends all the way up to some point central leader the recommend removal due to the size of the specimen and location as we believe the risk of damage could be extensive should it fail. T5 Sycamore; 15% reduction on the outer extremity of the canopy to relieve end load and create balanced canopy. T6 Sweet Chestnut; overhanging highway significantly. The tree is heavily loaded to the highway. Applying for 5.4 lift over highway and 3m reduction of heavily loaded branch work extending over highway. Sympathetically done this should maintain the form of the tree but reduce potential for failure of over extended limbs.
