

**Minutes of Ackworth Parish Council Playing Field and Changing Rooms
Committee held on Monday 29 June 2009 at the Parish Council Community
Centre commencing at 3.00 pm**

1. Apologies

Apologies were accepted from Cllr Tonkinson and Cllr Storey for reasons recorded in the attendance book.

2. Minutes of the meeting held on 18 May 2009

2.1 Cllr Johnson proposed and Cllr Barnsley seconded that the minutes were a true record. The Chairman duly signed them.

3. Matters Arising

3.1 Litterbin – it was agreed that the Clerk e mail the Chairman and copy Mr Brummitt at Wakefield MDC.

3.2 Water leak at Brackenhill – Clerk to contact Mr Platts for an update.

3.3. Work to be completed on the job advert

3.4 Low Ackworth fencing – the company who was asked to carry out the work had not responded. It was agreed that the Clerk purchase the required number of posts and under the supervision of Cllr Johnson they are installed by the Cemetery Staff.

4. To receive a letter from a resident of Brackenhill re the condition of Brackenhill Playing Field

4.1 The letter was discussed and it was agreed that part of the problem is that teams turn up to play on the field with without prior booking. It was agreed that a sign would be put up to say that “No training or matches are to be played on the field without pre booking with the Parish Council’.

4.2 A reply is to be sent to the resident informing him of this.

5. To discuss work required on the changing rooms before the start of the 2009/10 season

5.1 The clerk reported that the Unpaid Work Team had been in the changing rooms and painted and cleaned the shower block, the work was almost complete and it was a big improvement.

5.2 It was agreed that the doors on both changing rooms need to be stronger and the door casings need strengthening along with new security looks, which have keys that can't be copied and cut. It was further agreed that the Clerk writes to local joiners inviting them to supply a quote.
