A1 Darrington Interchange Waterproofing – essential maintenance - UPDATE

We are contacting you again to provide you with an update on essential maintenance work taking place at Darrington Interchange on the A1.

Due to recent storms work planned for February, did not go ahead. We now have new dates when we plan to complete the work.

A-one+ working on behalf of National Highways (formerly Highways England) is carrying out essential maintenance work on the A1 Darrington Interchange bridge. Our work will ensure the carriageway and bridge joints are well maintained and protected from the weather; this reduces the need for future roadworks in the area.

What's happening and when?

We are renewing the waterproofing and expansion joints, road surface and markings on the bridge at Darrington Interchange.

This work is essential; we must complete it to ensure that this section of the A1 is reliable and safe to use for customers while reducing the need for unplanned road closures in the future.

We will close the A1 for a weekend and midweek overnight on: -

- Southbound From 9pm Friday 18 March to 6am Monday 21 March
- Southbound From 9pm to 6am, Wednesday 23 and Thursday 24 March

The work is weather dependent; should there be any further delay due to adverse weather conditions we will update customers via the National Highways website and social media.

Closures and Diversions

During all the closures a fully signed diversion will be in place, and this has been agreed in advance with the police and local authority. We are working with partners to reduce motorway traffic on the local network by providing advanced warnings on the M1, M62 and A1M across the region.

All traffic

• For the Southbound closure HGV/Motorway traffic travelling south will be diverted off the A1M at Junction 32a near Ferrybridge onto the M62 and M18.
