Welcome to our Spring / Summer 2024 Newsletter





Bell Lane Community Centre



Situated on Bell Lane our community centre provides a valuable space to many groups, clubs, organisations and is perfect for parties. The centre has 3 rentable spaces all furnished ready for use.

Carr Bridge Pavilion 5.5m x 5m

The community room is perfect small groups, parties and meetings, ideally located next to Carr Bridge Playing Field.



Function Room 17m x 15m

The function room is our largest space and will suit most groups.



It is an ideal room for parties as it accommodates a small bouncy castle (H 2.4 m) and has access to a small kitchette for catering. There is disabled access throughout the building.

Brackenhill Community Room

5m x 3.55m



This room is ideal for regular courses and small groups with perfect access to the park and playing fields.

Multi-function Room 9m x 5.5m



Bright airy space with access to it's own kitchenette and toilet.

Council Room 7m x 5m

An ideal spacious meeting room with access to the upstairs kitchenette. This space can also accommodate small groups.
