 - That the Parish Council take part in the Green Canopy and purchase a tree for each school in the village
 - To hold a "Jubilee Best Piece of Art" competition and get the entrees made into a banner to be displayed at Carr Bridge
 - To see if funding is available from Wakefield Council
- 3.2. It was further agreed to recommend to the Parish Council that the room hire costs for Needles and Pins Craft Group is waived for the two days they will be using the centre to make bunting to decorate the village.

4. To discuss arrangements for Ackworth Gala 2022

- 4.1. A discussion took place. It was agreed to recommend to the Parish Council the following:

 - There will be no parade
 - The event will continue to be heavily focused on the opportunity for community groups and local charities to raise funds.
