1. Apologies

1.1. Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs S Balfour and M Galvin

2. To note the minutes of the meeting held on 7 February 2022

2.1. The minutes had previously been circulated to all Councillors and were noted.

3. Matter Arising from the minutes of 1 November 2021

3.1. Cllr Roberts gave an update following a meeting with Officers from Wakefield Council's Highways department.

3.2. No further updates to receive from Wakefield Council regarding the proposed safety improvements on A628 High Ackworth to Pontefract. The work was scheduled for November 2021 and rescheduled to February 2022.

It was agreed to recommend that an update is requested from Wakefield Council.

4. To receive an update on the request for a pedestrian crossing on A638 Wakefield Road

4.1. Wakefield Council advised that the petition had been received and a response was due to be sent to the petitioner. No further update has been received by the Parish Council. It was therefore agreed to recommend that the Parish Council contact the petitioner to see what progress had been made.
