The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.

1. To receive apologies for absence

3. To receive and note any matters arising from the minutes

3.1. Siting of the Pit Tub

Confirmation has been received that planning permission is required to site the pit tub on the grass verge at Carr Bridge. It was agreed to **recommend** that this is applied for.

3.3 Inclusive Play Equipment - Ongoing. Looking at grant funding

4. To discuss youth provision and recommend a course of action

4.1. A discussion took place.

Although the funded activities by Wakefield Council in the summer had been a success it was agreed that following a catch-up session with the youth at the Community Centre on Bell Lane earlier this month, the Parish Council has no suitable indoor space during the winter.

It was agreed to **recommend** that the Parish Council does support the ongoing provisions of youth services in the spring, and looks at funding streams\costs of providing such a service.

It was further agreed to **recommend** that the Parish Council signposts to the current activities available in the village and welcomes any groups who would be interested in providing provision to meet with the Parish Council to discuss options.

5. To consider a request from Wakefield Council to take ownership of the multiuse games area (MUGA)

5.1. A discussion took place. It was agreed to recommend that the Parish Council does not take ownership of the MUGA

6. To receive correspondence from a resident regarding trees at the Community Centre, Bell Lane

6.1. Correspondence had previously been circulated to all Councillors

It was agreed to **recommend** no further action. The Tree Hazard Assessment identified the required work and action will be taken on those tree as appropriate.
